The Belvoir Junior and Mini ODE is suitable for all young riders and is an ideal event for children to start their competitive journey.

Riders to be 13 years or under on 1st January 2026

Combination of horse and rider are **NOT** eligible if they have:

- Competed PC70 or above in the Area 6 Eventing League
 - Qualified for the Regional Eventing or Show Jumping Championships at PC70 or above
 - Competed PC70 or above in the Area 6 Winter Show Jumping League or Spring Festival Qualifier in SJ or Arena Eventing
 - Competed BS show jumping 70cm or above

Combinations may only enter one class and no multiple riders on the same pony.

Please note classes 1-3 are lead rein or assisted, classes 4-6 must be completed with no outside assistance.

Entry fee for ODE classes: £45.00 Non-Belvoir/Non PC; Belvoir members £40.00

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

Class 1 Mini One Day Event 30cm – Lead Rein 8yrs and under (As of 1st Jan)

On lead rein ALL disciplines All leaders must be over 14

Dressage: PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022

Class 2 Mini One Day Event 30cm – Assisted 8yrs and under (As of 1st Jan)

Off lead rein all disciplines, but may be assisted (must not be led, touched, or held whilst competing)

Dressage: PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022

Class 3 Pre-Intro One Day Event 40cm – Assisted

Off lead rein all disciplines, but may be assisted (must not be led, touched, or held whilst competing)

Dressage: PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022

Class 4 Pre-Intro One Day Event 40cm - Unassisted

Dressage: PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022

Class 5 Intro One Day Event 50cm - Unassisted

Changes to Entries: For ALL changes of horse and rider substitutions after the closing date please email entries.belvoir@pcuk.org. For all amendments before closing date, please use horse-events.

Withdrawals: Full refund up to the closing date; no refunds after the closing date.

Abandonment: In the event of the competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be given. In such an instance the refund policy will be communicated and must be followed.

Times: Will be posted on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk no later than Saturday 2nd May 2026 (after 6pm).

Scores: Will be posted on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk. Any queries should be raised with the event secretary at the information point.

Prize giving will take place at the end of each class

Competitor's numbers: Competitors* must supply their own numbers: number bibs with a printed number which you must print out at home (for the front and back of bib) from www.ponyclubresults.co.uk where you will find your times.

Dressage Callers: Callers are permitted for all dressage tests

Dressage Tests: Dressage Sheets will be available at the end of the class as soon as all results are in. Please leave a SAE in the box at the Information Point on the day if you would like your dressage test posting to you.

Entry is deemed to be acceptance of the following conditions:

This competition will be run under the relevant [Pony Club Rules 2026](#)

1. A valid passport including up to date flu vac record must be carried. Spot checks will be made at the event.
 2. All hats must be tagged to comply with the [Pony Club Hat Rule 2026](#), with a **PINK** hat tag. Hat tagging will be available at the information point.
 3. A body protector meeting BETA 2018 Level 3 Standard (blue and black label) must be worn for the cross country phase.
 4. Any pony club member wearing spurs must have a **YELLOW** hat tag issued by their own pony club for passing the pony club spurs test or holding their pony club C+ test.
 5. Whips:
For dressage - may be any length, up to 102cm, and carried during the dressage test.
For show jumping and cross country (including in the warmup) – the whip must be padded and comply with current BS standard, up to a maximum of 70cm.
 6. Horses/ponies must be 5 years and over.
 7. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition.
 8. Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended outside at any time.
 9. Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes.
 10. The decision of the judge is final and any objection must be made to the Secretary with a deposit of £20, refundable if the objection is upheld.
 11. Health & Safety: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials, and stewards.
 12. Legal Liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Photographic rights – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons on horses/ponies by the designated photographer at the event to be developed for sale and to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
