The Area 6 Mini Championships are for pony and rider combinations starting out on their competitive journey.

Riders to be 13 years or under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024

Combination of horse and rider are NOT eligible if they have:

- represented their branch/centre at Grassroots/PC80 Level or above in Dressage, Show Jumping or Eventing Area Competitions (including Spring Festivals) this year, or in previous years
- completed PC70 or above in the Area 6 Eventing League

### For Show Jumping and Eventing Mini Championships

- qualified for the Regional Eventing or Show Jumping Championships at PC70 this year, or in previous years
- completed PC70 or above in the Area 6 Winter Show Jumping League
- competed BS show jumping 70cm or above

## For Dressage Mini Championships

- qualified for the Regional Dressage Championships at PC70 this year, or in previous years
- completed Grassroots or above in the Area 6 Winter Dressage League
- competed Prelim or above with British Dressage, including Team/My Quest

## Area 6 Mini Championships in Dressage, Show Jumping and Eventing

Combinations of pony and rider can enter <u>either</u> 1 One Day Event class<u>or</u> a combination of dressage and show jumping classes (max of 3 classes which could include 2 consecutive classes in either dressage or showjumping).

Combinations entered for the One Day Event classes will also include entry in the Area 6 Mini Dressage Championship and Mini Show Jump Championship for that level.

#### Entry fee for ODE classes: £45.00; Blankney members £39.00

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

#### Class 1 Mini One Day Event

<u>On lead rein ALL disciplines All leaders must be over 14</u> Dressage: <u>PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022</u> Fences: Height max 30cm

#### Class 2 Mini One Day Event

<u>Off lead rein all disciplines, but may be assisted (must not be led, touched, or held whilst on competing)</u> Dressage: <u>PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022</u> Fences: <u>Height max 30cm</u>

#### Class 3 Pre-Intro One Day Event

Dressage: <u>PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022</u> Fences: Height max 40cm

#### Class 4 Intro One Day Event

Dressage: Preliminary PC70 Dressage Test 2022 Fences: Height max 50cm

#### Class 5 One Day Event

Dressage: Preliminary PC70 Dressage Test 2022 Fences: Height max 60cm

Changes to Entries: For ALL changes of horse and rider substitutions before or after the closing date please email entriesblankney@gmail.com

Withdrawals: Full refund up to the closing date; no refunds after the closing date.

Abandonment: In the event of the competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be given. In such an instance the refund policy will be communicated and must be followed

## Area 6 Mini Championships in Dressage

#### Entry fee for Dressage classes: £15.00; Blankney members £13.00

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

If you have entered the One Day Event, you are automatically entered into the Area 6 Mini Dressage Championships: you use the same dressage test for both.

- Class 6 Mini Dressage (Lead Rein) PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022
- Class 7 Mini Dressage (assisted) PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022
- Class 8 Pre-Intro Dressage (unassisted) PC Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022
- Class 9 Dressage (split into 2 sections if sufficient entries) Prelim PC70 Dressage Test 2022

## Area 6 Mini Championships in Show Jumping

#### Entry fee for Show Jumping classes: £15.00; Blankney members £13.00

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

If you have entered the One Day Event, you are automatically entered into the Area 6 Mini Show Jumping Championships: you use the same show jumping round for both.

#### All classes are SINGLE PHASE

Approx 12 fences in total with faults accrued throughout – all penalties go forward for the One Day Event. All riders will jump the full course, even with faults in the first half, unless eliminated. The second section of the course will be timed.

Show Jump Champion is the rider with the fewest (or zero) total faults with the fastest time in the second section.

- Class 10 Mini Show Jumping (Lead Rein) Height: 30cm max
- Class 11 Mini Show Jumping (assisted) Height: 30cm max
- Class 12 Pre-Intro Show Jumping Height: 40cm max
- Class 13 Intro Show Jumping Height: 50cm max
- Class 14 Show Jumping Height: 60cm max

**Times**: Will be posted on <u>www.ponyclubresults.co.uk</u> no later than Friday 11<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

**Scores:** will be posted on <u>www.ponyclubresults.co.uk</u> Any queries should be raised with the event secretary at the information point.

**Prize giving will take place at the end of each class** Individual Rosettes for each section 1<sup>st</sup> to 8th, sash for the winner, prizes to 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each section.

**Competitor's numbers:** Competitors must supply their own numbers: **number bibs** with a printed number which you must print out at home (for the front and back of bib) from <u>www.ponyclubresults.co.uk</u> where you will find your times.

Commanders: Commanders are permitted for all dressage tests

**Dressage Tests:** Dressage Sheets will be available at the end of the class as soon as all results are in. Please leave a SAE in the box at the Information Point on the day if you would like your dressage test posting to you.

Whips: May be of any length and carried during the test.

## All hats must be tagged to comply with the <u>Pony Club Hat Rule 2024</u>, with a <u>PINK</u> hat tag. HAT tagging will be available at the information point.

Body protectors, BETA Level 3 2018 standard, must be worn for XC phase.

Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended outside at any time.

Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes.
